The pool, tennis courts and grounds must be vacated by 10:00 PM.

PLEASE READ RULES BEFORE ENTERING POOL AREA

- 1. PERSONS SWIMMING DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.**
- 2. AN ADULT may use the pool at any time during operating hours. An adult is a person 18 years of age or older.**
- 3. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 7 YEARS OLD must be accompanied by an adult. This applies even when a lifeguard is present.**
- 4. CHILDREN UNDER 16 YEARS OLD, a responsible adult eighteen years of age or older must accompany the children and be in the pool or on the pool deck and attentive at all times the children use the facility, except when a lifeguard is present**
- 5. PERSONS BETWEEN THE AGES OF 16 AND 18 YEARS OLD, a minimum of two people 16 years or older must be at the pool facility at all times the pool is in use, except when a lifeguard is present.**
- 6. NO RUNNING, PUSHING, OR OTHER “HORSEPLAY” are allowed in the fenced pool area.**
- 7. NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are allowed in the fenced pool area. Anyone considered being under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be asked to leave the facilities.**
- 8. NO GLASS CONTAINERS are allowed in the fenced pool area.**
- 9. NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES are allowed within 4 feet of the pool edge.**
- 10. DIVING is only permitted in the diving well where water is at least 7 feet deep.**

11. NO LOUD, BOISTEROUS, OR OBSCENE LANGUAGE or disorderly or unsuitable conduct will be permitted anywhere in the park area.
12. NO LOUD MUSIC is permitted anywhere in the park area.
13. ALL FURNITURE AND FLOAT TOYS on the pool deck must be at least 4 feet from the edge of the pool.
14. FLOAT TOYS are only permitted during non-busy times. Any MEMBER may request the removal of a float toy should it interfere with normal swimming activity. LIFE RAFTS, FLOATING ISLANDS, AND INNER TUBES are not permitted in the pool.
15. HARD PLASTIC TOYS OR ANYTHING NOT MADE SPECIFICALLY FOR POOL USE is not allowed in the pool.
16. CUT-OFF SHORTS OR RAGGED CLOTHING is not permitted in the pool. Swimsuits are preferred. Clean, hemmed, and non-hole shorts and t-shirts may be worn.
17. ADEQUATE PROTECTION FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT TOILET TRAINED IS REQUIRED. **Disposable diapers are not allowed.** Adequate protection consists of tight fitting swim pants or cloth diapers with plastic pants and swimsuits. Diapers should be checked regularly to reduce the risk of fecal matter in the water.
18. WADING POOL is only for young children and must be accompanied and supervised by an adult poolside. LIFEGUARD IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR WATCHING THE WADING POOL. Older children are not permitted and will be asked to leave the wading pool.
19. NO PETS ARE ALLOWED, except for animals needed for service as guide dogs on the deck only.

20. A NON-MEMBER may not use the facility except as a GUEST of a MEMBER who shall be in the COMPANY of the GUEST and be responsible for his or her conduct.
21. NO MORE THAN 2 GUESTS ARE ALLOWED FOR MEMBERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE.
22. NO MORE THAN 5 GUESTS PER FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS ARE ALLOWED AT ONE TIME.
23. PRIOR APPROVAL IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PARTIES. A member must be responsible for all aspects of the party (including cleanup!) and adherence to pool rules and rules pertaining to parties. Contact the Pool Manager for prior approval.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in suspension of privileges.
